



Are you looking for ways to Support Pandora Arts Collective Society, but don't have the Funds to do so?

Here are three ways you can help:

Canadian Tire Money: Yes we accept Canadian Tire Money. Do you have family or friends that don't want their Canadian Tire Money? Yes it is ok to donate the five and ten cent denominations as they all add up. What will we do with our Canadian Tire Money? We can buy supplies such as paper, scissors, glue brushes and many other things. We collected \$15 Canadian Tire Dollars. We spent it on Exacto knives that were needed for the studio. Send in more Canadian Tire Money so we can purchase more items.

Shopper's Optimum Points: Do you shop at Shoppers Drug Mart? Do you have a Shopper's Optimum Card? If yes, you can donate some or all of your points online. If you don't have a Shopper's Optimum card it easy to get one. Either ask for an application or fill in one on-line. The points are all donated and collected online. Points add up quite quickly! The points turn into dollars and then PACS buys supplies with them. We can buy anything from electronics to paint. Just before Christmas we used the Shoppers Optimum Points to buy a First Aid Kit. Unfortunately we had to use it, so lucky we had just bought the First Aid Kit.

Daisy Dollars: For every Island Farms UCP code we get three cents. When we have a total of 500 UCP codes we take them into Island Farms and they will give us a cheque to spend on anything we require. Right now we have a total of 439 UCP codes. We only need 61 more to get a cheque. Please bring in the Island Farms UCP codes. Cut out the entire UCP code including the two lone numbers on the outside of the code. Ask friends and neighbours who drink Island Farms milk, use butter, sour cream or any other Island Farms products to save the codes.

All of these things may seem to be small amounts, however, it really helps PACS to buy supplies as we have a tight budget.
